

GOVERNMENT PROPERTY BASIC SALES AGREEMENTS

INVITATION

This invitation is issued to solicit proposals for the purpose of establishing Basic Sales Agreements (BSAs) with companies interested in bidding on truck load lots of government-owned surplus personal property.

Forms to participate in the BSAs must be received no later than **March 13, 2015**.

This is NOT an assignment of government owned surplus property. It is a sale of government owned surplus property to the highest bidder.

UT-Battelle, LLC (the "Company" or "UT-Battelle") operates the Oak Ridge National Laboratory ("ORNL") for the Department of Energy (DOE) pursuant to Contract No. DE-AC0500OR22725. On average, 3,500 excess and or surplus items are excessed/surplused each month. These items come from not only ORNL, but from other DOE Contractors, and other government agencies in Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

The types of items to be sold to BSA holders include, but are not limited to, technical and scientific equipment, machinery and machine parts, and office equipment and furniture. This agreement excludes the following types of property: scrap metals, tires, batteries, cardboard, electronics, oils, and broken furniture, vehicles designated as exchange sale per GSA/DOE regulations, export controlled/proliferation sensitive items, and other items as determined by the Company.

The Government-owned property is located in Oak Ridge, Tennessee on Union Valley Road or at other locations identified by the Company. The BSAs will be awarded for a two-year period with options for three, one-year periods. The Company does not obligate itself to provide any specified quantity of material for sale.

UT-Battelle intends to enter into BSAs with all responsible companies. UT-Battelle will consider a company to be responsible if it agrees to all terms and conditions in the BSA contract and certifies that it meets the requirements established in the "Representations and Certifications (Jan. 2015)."

Companies interested in entering into a BSA should download a copy of the BSA contract, the Representations and Certifications form, and Warehouse Safety Rules.

The BSA contract (first page only) and the Representations and Certifications forms should be completed (grayed areas) and returned to Ms. Cheri Cross, crosscl@ornl.gov, by March 13, 2015.
